Protected trees are any living native shade tree set forth on the table below or Sabal Palm/Cabbage Palm (Sabal Palmetto) having a DBH of 4 inches or greater and that is not specifically excluded from protection or a Dead Tree.

Replacement trees are to have a trunk diameter of 2 inches measured at twelve (12) inches above grade and be eight (8) foot in height with a spread of four (4) feet. Trees to meet ‘Grades and Standards for Nursery Plants’ Florida Grade 1 or better.
